Vidar R

Vidar R is a workboat and tug for towing, anchor handling, pipe handling, and ploughing, and is fitted with a hydraulic A-frame, as well as a towing hook. The knuckle boom crane at SWL 2t can handle spare parts, and assist where necessary.

With a vertical rubber-covered push bow, Vidar R can safely accommodate crew transfers. A flybridge control system allows for superior high-safety manoeuvring.

With a bollard pull of 5t, Vidar R is capable of handling a variety of tasks.
