Sleipner R

Sleipner R is a versatile workboat optimised for supporting stationary dredgers, crew transfers, anchor handling, and the delivery of stores and bunker supplies.

The vessel is equipped with an A-frame for ploughing operations, a seabed water-injection system, and a 2-tonne hydraulic deck crane with an 8-metre reach, enabling efficient support across a range of marine operations.

With a bollard pull of 7.6 tonnes, Sleipner R is also capable of undertaking various towing operations.
