Vidar R

Vidar R is a workboat and tug designed for towing, anchor handling, pipe handling, and ploughing operations. The vessel is equipped with a hydraulic A-frame and a towing hook, providing flexibility for a range of marine and offshore tasks.

The 2-tonne SWL knuckle boom crane is capable of handling spare parts and assisting in operational support where required.

With its vertical rubber-covered push bow, Vidar R can safely accommodate crew transfers, while the flybridge control system ensures excellent visibility and enables safe and precise manoeuvring.

With a bollard pull of 5 tonnes, Vidar R is capable of supporting a range of marine operations.
